- Partnered with Growth Action Network and succeeded in changing Anne Arundel County code on Cluster Development and Peer Review Program
- Continued to closely follow developments including 51-61 East Joyce Lane, Admiral's Ridge, Enclave at Shore Acres, EZ Storage, Hagan Townhouses, Montessori School, Village at Stephen's Woods and became involved where appropriate
- Assisted in completing feasibility study to connect the Broadneck trail to the B & A trail
- Hosted three weekend clean-ups on Route 2
- Sponsored Century Ride Rest Stop for third year at Arnold Station
- Co-Sponsored 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Eastern District National Night Out
- Strongly advocated for the replacement of Arnold Elementary School and subsequently for the timely funding of construction, both of which came to fruition.
- Participated for first time in Severna Park 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade
- Held joint meeting with Greater Severna Park Council for a legislative review
