Administration updated us on the projects planned for Route 2 from Route 50 to Earleigh Heights. He passed around a sheet listing 15 different sections of Route 648, Baltimore & Annapolis Boulevard, all carrying the same name. He noted that the 648 section Arnold is concerned about is referred to as 648D.
