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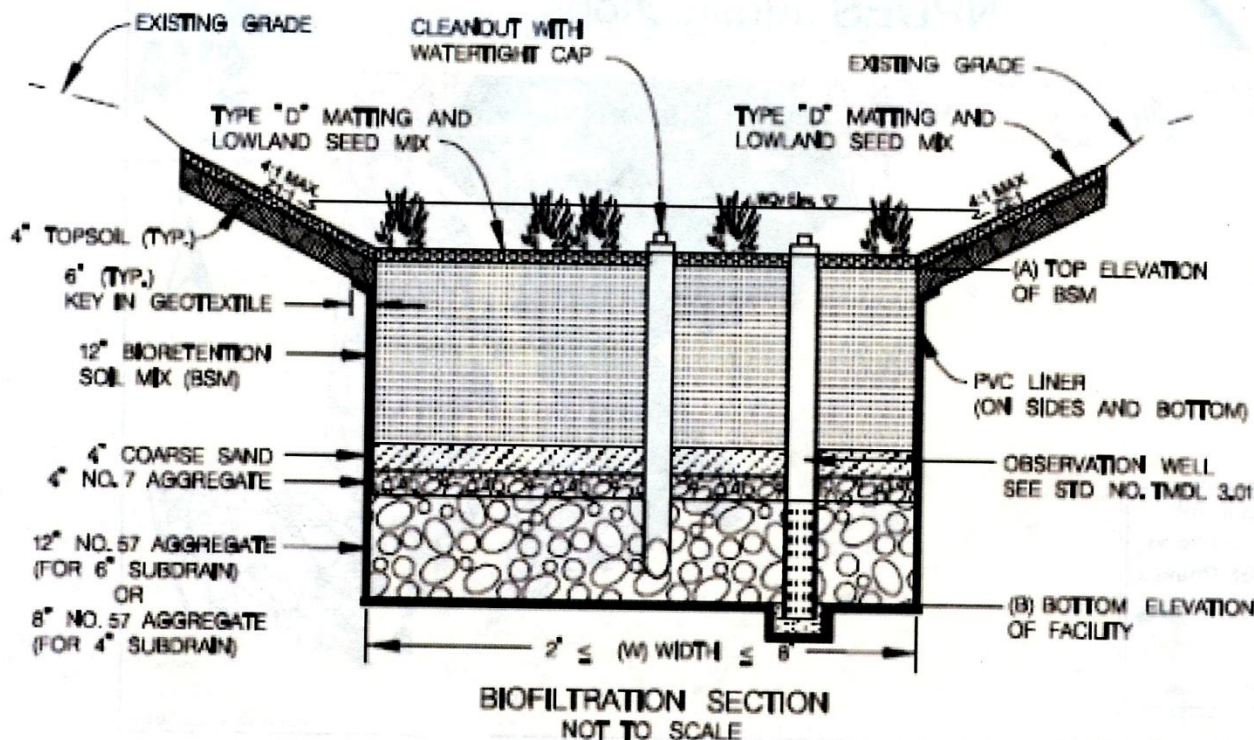

OCTOBER GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

The October General Membership meeting was called to order at 7:35 pm at Asbury United Methodist Church with 21 members present.

President Elizabeth Rosborg welcomed everyone and introduced the speaker for the evening, Mr. Robert Shreeve, SHA Deputy Director, Office of Environmental Design. Mr. Shreeve explained the purpose of "bioswales" now being constructed in the median strip of Ritchie Highway from the Route 50 intersection north to Pasadena. Each "bioswale" is an independent water filtration plant which filters highway water runoff and reduces pollutants (particularly nitrogen) entering local streams, creeks and rivers that feed the Chesapeake Bay.

When questioned about the purity of the output, Mr. Shreeve chuckled when he said, " Now I wouldn't tell you to go out and drink that water, but it's a lot cleaner than when it went in."
