OLD BUSINESS:

CVS is moving along and they hope to open mid November.



APC met with Inspections and Permits regarding signs. The county is aware of the Arnold citizen frustrations, although no solutions were presented. APC completed numerous request for investigation forms, and several signs have been removed.

APC presented Friends of Anne Arundel Trails outgoing president, Elizabeth Wyble with an inscribed autograph Arnold book thanking her for 20 years of dedication.

NEW BUSINESS:

The website has been updated with 2 new sketch plans. The first, is a revised plan for the Hawk/Webb property off of Route 2, between Admiral’s Ridge and the Goddard School. This revised plan removes 33% of the originally proposed retaining wall and saves 5 specimen trees. It also adds a forest conservation easement between the edge of the property and Admiral’s Ridge, next to Arnold Elemnetary School property.

The second plan added is for proposed single family houses at 364 Freshfield Lane next to the Providence Center on Shore Acres Road. The community meeting has been held and the initial plans submitted as shown.
