

Executive Summary 2021

APC focused on keeping their members informed during the COVID-19 pandemic that consumed us this past year. We had only 2 in-person meetings in 2020. After mid-March, APC kept in touch with its members through e-mail and the website.

However, the work continued. APC worked with Wroxeter Estates over the new entrance that was appealed and with continuing issues involving Dogwood Senior Mobile Home Park. It also worked with the county and the state Highway Administration regarding Tommy's Proposed Car Wash and proposed improvements all along Route 2.

APC was involved with Plan2040, including proposed Land Use changes. In addition, there were a few specific issues in Arnold, that APC was able to assist with.

APC also worked with Councilwoman Fielder on a variety of legislation including agritourism, and cluster development.

In 2021, APC expects to continue working with the state assembly and County Council. The adoption and implementation of Plan 2040 will be a top priority. When the regional planning process begins, APC will play an integral part.
