

Where APC Directed its Efforts in 2021

Arnold Preservation Council

- Continued to be very active in monitoring development projects, including Wroxeter Estates, Tommy's Car Wash, Ford's Grant, Freshfield Lane and Chick-fil-A. There have been numerous community meetings attended by APC, discussions with developers and with Anne Arundel County officials, and deliberations by the Board and supporters of APC.
- Facilitated meetings between Rugby Hall HOA and Uchilyn LLC, the developer of Wroxeter Estates, which resulted in a memorandum of agreement and a withdrawal of an administrative appeal.
- Kept abreast of county and state studies, plans and initiatives regarding improvements to Route 2, and hosted an informational meeting with state highway officials.
- Studied the county-generated Green Infrastructure Master Plan draft and submitted comments.
- Continued to follow up with the county and state on possible improvements to East Joyce Lane in the vicinity of Route 2.
- Kept up to date on issues related to the possible building of a new Bay Bridge.
- Continued to work closely with Growth Action Network to monitor issues affecting residents in Arnold and throughout the county.
- Upgraded its website.
- Again participated in the State Highway Administration's Adopt-a-Highway program by sponsoring clean-ups of an Arnold segment of Route 2.
- Resumed sponsoring, after a year's hiatus, a rest station for the Lifeline 100 bicycle event.
- Continued to maintain a flower bed on the B&A trail near West Joyce Lane.
- Assisted in the creation of a pocket park near the B&A trail and Severn Way.
- Were fortunate to have member Steve Miller appointed to the Area 4 Region Planning Committee.
- Held several membership meetings and sent out numerous newsletters and informative emails.

Expected Issues of Concern in 2022

Several of APC's 2021 efforts will be given further attention in 2022 and there will also be new concerns. Below are some of each.

- Continue monitoring development projects, new and existing, especially Tommy's Car Wash, Freshfield Lane and Chick-fil-A.
